Worried about what?

Philippians 4:6

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

The above verse tells us not to be anxious or stressed out about anything. We may find that difficult to do given the stresses of daily life that we have to endure, but are we any different than other generations past?
